2022 Spring Courses Description

<u>Cartooning (1:00PM - 1:50PM)</u>: recommended for students aged 9 and older, they will be able to develop their own artistic styles by frequent drawing and sketching. They will learn character designs and poses, as well as different perspectives to make backgrounds. Students will also get opportunities to make their own comics or illustrations.

<u>Introduction to Art (1:55PM-2:45PM):</u> recommended for students aged 4-6, they will learn essential techniques for using lines, shapes, and colors through drawing different kinds of subject matter such as familiar objects, animals, cartoon characters, and nature. They will also be encouraged in creative drawing through their own imagination.

<u>Draw/Color/Sketch (2:55PM-3:45PM)</u>: recommended for students aged 6-9, they will learn elements of art and principles of designs, and how to use materials and techniques to draw different kinds of subject matter such as familiar objects, nature, animals, cartoon characters, portraits, landscapes, etc. They will also be encouraged in creative drawing through their own imagination.

<u>Pastel Drawing (3:50PM-4:40PM):</u> recommended for students aged 6 and older, they will learn different kinds of techniques, and how to use pastels to draw different kinds of subject matter such as objects, landscapes, and portraits. Drawing and sketching are also taught, combined with the application of pastels. Oil pastels will be used as sketchy and more detailed effects, while soft pastels will be used as a more painterly effect.
