To ensure our young authors make steady progress through their multi-page literary projects, some weeks will require independent homework to be completed before the next class session. This independent writing and reflection time allows students to arrive at each workshop fully prepared for editing, peer feedback, and advanced stylistic lessons.

Narrative Architecture: Mastering the Mechanics of Storytelling

A great story requires far more than inspiration; it requires a deep understanding of structural design. Our curriculum guides students through the exact techniques used by published authors to build compelling worlds:

- **Plot Structure & Sequencing (ILS.W.3-4.3.A):** Students will learn to establish a clear situation, introduce a narrator or characters, and organize a logical event sequence that unfolds naturally, avoiding the erratic pacing common in early writing.
- **Character Development & Dialogue (ILS.W.3-4.3.B):** Your child will learn to move beyond flat characters by utilizing dialogue, descriptions of actions, thoughts, and feelings to develop experiences or show how characters respond to situations.
- **Descriptive Word Choice & Voice (ILS.W.3-4.3.D):** We systematically expand your child's expressive vocabulary. Writers will learn to use precise words and phrases, descriptive details, and sensory language to convey experiences and events vividly.

Composition & Editing: From Drafting to Publication

Excellent storytelling must be paired with flawless technical execution. We teach students that the magic of writing happens in the editing process, transforming raw ideas into polished prose:

- **The Writing Process (ILS.W.3-4.5):** With guidance from the instructor and peers, students will learn to plan, revise, and edit their work. We focus on strengthening writing by focusing on a clear purpose and audience.
- **Advanced Language Mechanics & Grammar (ILS.L.3-4.1-3):** A captivating story can be derailed by weak mechanics. We place a heavy emphasis on command of standard

English grammar, including complex sentence structures, precise comma usage in dialogue, correct capitalization, and advanced spelling patterns.

- **Paragraphing & Transitions (ILS.W.3-4.3.C):** Students will master the art of the transitional word or phrase (e.g., *meanwhile*, *suddenly*, *after a while*, *as a result*) to manage the sequence of events and smoothly transition from one paragraph or scene to the next.

This workshop bridges the gap between a child's imagination and professional, structured composition. By the conclusion of the course, your child will possess a portfolio of original written work and a permanent toolkit of advanced writing strategies. We look forward to a semester of incredible stories, thoughtful critiques, and immense academic growth.
