The modern version (力) is a powerful graphic impression of the forearm - a symbol of physical strength. Moral strength, however, is more to be desired. And those who go by the rule: "Might is right" will soon have to learn that "Right is might". In the original form the long middle line curved at the top. It represents the sinew that binds muscle to bone. The other line pictures the fibrous sheath of the sinew.

It is made of a Chinese phrase: (gun3 gual lan4 shu2). The phrases means one memories learned materials very well and the materials become a part of one's own.
