Theory of Knowledge (TOK) is an exciting and high energy course that teaches a practical type of philosophy to help students consider issues from a variety of perspectives. In this course we will be reading a number of articles and watching video clips to analyze. We will be exploring various topics through different lenses including: a Scientific way of knowing, an emotional way of knowing, and a logical way of knowing. We will analyze the strengths and limitations of various ways of knowing and develop an understanding of which ways of knowing are best in which circumstances. We will also be learning logic and developing logical ways of knowing through various brain games and exercises. Theory of Knowledge is a required class in parts of France and Switzerland and is an important part of higher level education courses; including, those of the International Baccalaureate (IB).

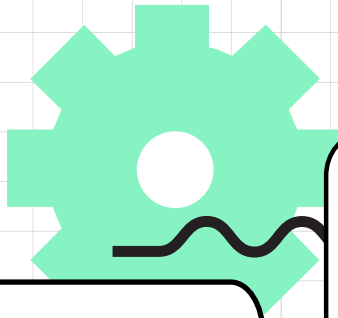
### Description:

6:00-7:50PM

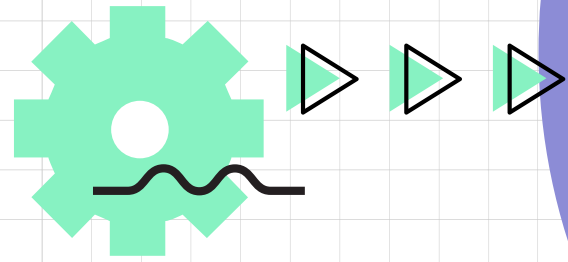
**Description:**

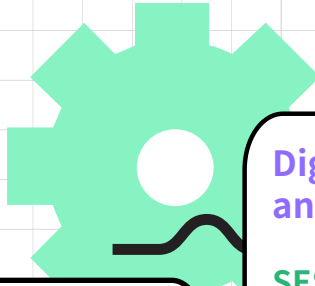


## Mr. Ryan Li's Bio English & Test Prep

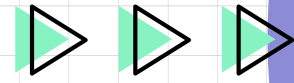
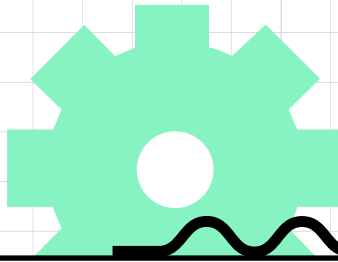


# Hello!

## 围棋数学 Weiqi / Go and Math

Level1 Tue 4:30P - 5:20P

### Description:

围棋起源于古代的中国。经过至少3000年发展，她已经发展演变成为娱乐、消遣、游戏、职业竞技项目的综合体，也是一种极具东方特色的艺术文化形式。“围棋数学”这门创新的学科则诞生于美国，她返璞归真地将围棋发展成为数学课堂的玩具教具学具。美国 Go and Math Academy 的研究表明，仅围棋这一个游戏就可以覆盖K-3 年级数学课堂中大约60%的内容(围棋在其他方面的教育意义更是远超过这个范围)。本课程将以围棋这个游戏为核心，以教育理念贯穿指导，让孩子们通过玩(专门为数学教育设计的)围棋来探索学习数学基本知识，在游戏中学数学于无形，帮助学生们理解基本的数学概念、掌握丰富的数学知识、培养敏锐的数字感觉、锻炼严谨的数学思维。(报名不需要任何围棋知识的基础。)

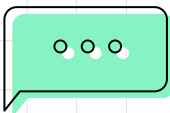
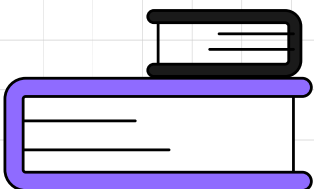
